Anticipated sightings of the crescent new moon from Israel:

Rosh Chodesh begins the evening of the sighting of the new moon and that night through the following daytime is the first day of the new month. Dates specified are dates for evening the new moon can be sighted.

Anticipated 2009 Fall Appointed Times:

These are the Sabbaths that you will need to arrange for time off of work. Feast of Tabernacles (Hag Sukkot) is a 7-day feast beginning with a Sabbath on the first day of Sukkot and followed immediately by Shemini Atzeret, also a Sabbath:

1st Day Hag Sukkot (Tabernacles)	Sunday, October 4, 2009	Monday, October 5, 2009
Shemini Atzeret (Eighth Day)	Sunday, October 11, 2009	Monday, October 12, 2009
